

# Customer information clause

**IMPLEMENTING art. 13 GDPR** (REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Regulation data protection))

- 2. Purpose of personal data processing:** Your personal data is processed by us for the conclusion and performance of a contract for the sale of our goods or services, verification of payment credibility, determination, defense and redress, direct marketing.
- 3. The basis for the processing of personal data together with a description of the legitimate interests pursued by the administrator:** your personal data is processed by us pursuant to art. 6 clause 1 lit. b GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary to perform the contract to which the data subject is party or to take action at the request of the data subject before concluding the contract. Another important aspect is the provision of art. 6 clause 1 lit. c GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary to fulfill the legal obligation incumbent on the administrator, e.g. legal provisions that require us to process data for tax and accounting purposes. Another important aspect is the provision of art. 6 clause 1 lit. f GDPR, i.e. processing is necessary for purposes resulting from legitimate interests pursued by the administrator or by a third party, e.g. enforcement of receivables, marketing of our products or services.
- 4. Information about the recipients of personal data:** Your personal data may be transferred to recipients and other third parties to achieve the purposes listed in point 2 in so far as they are necessary to perform the tasks ordered by the data controller, if required by law or if the administrator has a different legal basis. Your personal data may be transferred to: authorized bodies and economic information offices, as well as - if necessary - institutions dealing with debt collection; courier or postal service providers; transport or forwarding companies; other people within your organization.
- 5. Information about the intention to transfer personal data to a third country:** As a rule, the administrator does not transfer personal data of customers to recipients located outside the European Economic Area. However, the Customer's Personal Data may be transferred outside the EEA, which may result from the performance of forwarding orders outside the EEA. In the above cases, clients' personal data is protected by standard data protection clauses, which according to art. 46 section 2 GDPR provide adequate safeguards for data transfers to countries outside the EEA.
- 6. Information on the period of storage of personal data :** Your personal data will be stored in connection with the purchase of our goods or services and for the period of pursuing

claims, performing obligations arising from legal provisions, in particular tax and accounting law.

**7. Information on the right to access personal data, rectification, deletion of personal data or restriction of processing, on the right to object and the right to data transfer:** We ensure the exercise of rights under the GDPR, i.e. we provide access to our own personal data (information about data, copy of data); correction of data; deletion of data (processed unreasonably); limitation of processing (suspending operations on data or not deleting data - as per the application submitted); transferring data to another data administrator. To the extent that the basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 clause 1 lit. f GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, in particular for the purposes of marketing our products or services

**8. Information about the right to bring a complaint to the supervisory authority:** You have the right to bring a complaint to the supervisory authority dealing with personal data protection.

**9. Information whether the provision of personal data is a statutory or contractual requirement or a condition for concluding a contract and whether the data subject is required to provide it and what are the possible consequences of not providing data:**

Providing personal data is voluntary when marketing our products or services. Providing personal data when concluding a contract for the sale of our products or services is voluntary, however, it is a condition for issuing a document for the release of the good / service or invoice.
